Transport.

Congestion and Emission Zones:

Birmingham has a Clean Air Zone to improve air quality. If your vehicle does not
meet emissions standards, you may need to pay a charge to drive within this
zone. Use the GOV.UK service to check if your vehicle requires payment and view
maps of clean air zones⁶.
